The InSite™ system puts a secure, automated remote dispensing unit at the care facility, and uses powerful software to ensure the right medications are available on-demand, accessed by the right personnel, and packaged for a specific patient. The process is automated, accurate, and can quickly package pharmacist-approved medications before each medication pass, or on-demand to facilitate new residents, First Doses, and PRNs.



## INSITE: Streamlining the Medication Dispensing Process

### ELIMINATES WASTE & SAVES TIME

InSite can virtually eliminate medication waste by dramatically reducing or eliminating the need to create time-consuming, waste-prone blister packs. The average InSite canister holds about 300 doses, and can be filled and processed in about the same time it takes to create a single 30-day blister pack.

#### **InSite enables automated and accurate dispensing:**

- Medications are dispensed only as needed, and for a specific patient or medication pass
- Changes in prescribed medications or patient residency will no longer produce unused blister packs that need to be destroyed or returned
- It reduces the number of medication deliveries and expensive special courier runs required
- InSite can provide inventory and dispensing information for down-to-the-dose accountability at each facility



With InSite, medication orders are transmitted to the pharmacist for clinical review. After approval, the medications are immediately available at the long-term care facility and dispensed from the InSite remote dispensing unit with patient-specific packaging.

- Before delivery, each canister is filled, security sealed, checked and signed by the pharmacist
- Allows automatic inventory monitoring and lot and expiration tracking

- Restricts access to stored medications with password-protection and locking metal doors
- Packages up to 60 doses per minute with a broad variety of sorting options
- Enables additional nursing time for patient safety issues such as fall-prevention
